TUITION REQUIREMENTS

Year 10

Students need to purchase printing credits for subjects as required. These are available from the main office in \$1, \$2 and \$5 cards

All students are required to have basic pencil case equipment, eg pencil, pens, ruler, eraser, compass, etc. Some items may need replacing as the year progresses. All students need a bag to carry school gear in!
